LOOKING FORWARDWhat in the world is God up to?

This is the question that Edna and I have been asking ourselves quite a bit over the last couple of months; even more over the last couple of weeks. There are two big things that God has been working on the most. One is working with churches and professional adults in and around Chiapas. The other is partnering with Dennis Rainey and Family Life ministries.

Chiapas:

First, let me tell you about Chiapas and what God is putting together there. Benjamin Loera was in Madisonville the last week of March. He was able to spend some time with us as he was traveling to different churches trying to raise some additional support. During the time he was with us, we were able to spend quite a bit of time visiting about the needs in Chiapas. The needs there are many, but what I believe to be the biggest need is training. Benjamin was telling me that they have a large group of pastors who are preaching but don't know anything about discipleship or leading the church. They are in desperate need of someone to come for short periods of time to train and mentor them

One of the comments that Benjamin made was that here in America, we have unlimited resources. We have the internet, books, training material, and people we can ask. But in Chiapas there are very few resources. And most of the resources are not doctrinally sound. The internet, computers, and cell phones are readily available in the big cities of southern Mexico, but once you leave them, cell and internet service is sporadic. Because of this, it greatly limits the resources available to the pastors in the smaller towns and outlying areas.

Pastors are begging that I come to Chiapas and continue what Earnest had started. They are asking for additional training beyond what the DVDs cover. One of the issues they are facing right now is how to disciple their church members. They know how to get them saved but are not sure what things they need to be teaching them as a church body.

On June 23rd and 24th there is a pastor's conference scheduled with about 80 pastors from the area. This conference is already scheduled with them believing that God is going to provide the funds for us to be there. If we are not able to go, then the conference will be canceled. They are asking that we come and teach them how to disciple their church members and also train the young professional men on ministering to others.

If we are able to purchase the tickets this month, the cost will be around \$2300. If we wait until next month, then the cost goes up to \$2800. If we wait until June, then the cost will be around \$3500 - \$4000.

Please pray with us as we believe God to provide the funds for us to be able to go and minister to these pastors and to the people of Chiapas.

Over the last 6 to 8 months God has been pouring into Edna and me material and training involving marriage and families. As He has been training us, we have been talking, and seeking His face, as to what He would have us do with all of the information we are being taught. Edna and I now believe that He would have us minister, train, and teach couples on what it is to have a Godly Christian home.

We see in the book of Genesis that the first thing God instituted between man and woman was the plan of marriage. We also see Satan show up on the scene to destroy what God had but together. Ever since then, Satan has set out to destroy as many families as he possibly could. The devil does not want to see Godly families succeed because of the representation and

the blessing that God has put on the family.
A door that has recently opened is the opportunity to partner with Family Life Ministry. Family Life Ministry has been around for over 40 years. It was started by Dennis and Barbara Rainey and focuses on marriages, families, and kids. They have been teaching Biblical truths and strate-gies on how to keep your focus on God to achieve a wholesome Godly marriage and family.

A couple of months ago, Edna and I were able to participate in one of their events. It was a week-long seminar with a ton of vital information. As we were attending, we felt like God would have us visit with some of the Family Life directors that were sharing about opportunities to partner with Family Life. We weren't sure what God was doing but felt led to gather information

and fill out a volunteer card. After having a very detailed conversation with one of the directors, it was recommended that we contact the Houston regional director and meet with him. We got back to Madison-ville and got busy with catching up with ministry and chores. A couple of weeks ago we received a phone call from the Houston Director. We would later learn that out of 2500 volunteer cards, our card had been taken out of the pile and placed on his desk, and that he had been highly encouraged to call us. Had our card stayed in the pile, we probably would have never heard from him. It is absolutely amazing when God puts things together.

Let me clarify that we are not accepting a job with Family Life, but instead, we are partnering with them to be able to reach families and marriages that are in trouble or need encouraging. We will still continue all of the ministries of Word of Truth and Word of Truth will continue moving forward. Word of Truth is not going away. We are not closing down WOT and becoming Family Life. We are simply partnering with Family Life as another resource to minister to those in need. We will not be receiving any financial support from Family Life They are providing us with material and training, both in English and Spanish, so that we may reach families in need.

The way we will be doing this is by sharing with churches and individuals opportunities for couples to attend some of the seminars in our area. These seminars are in areas all over the US, Mexico, and S. America. They have been ministering for years, and they are seeing souls won to Christ and broken marriages and families being restored. But the biggest thing that is happening through these seminars is that people are returning to God and learning how to make Him Lord over there life. The testimonies I could share with you are miracles that God is performing through this ministry

The other way that we will be reaching couples is by offering, and leading groups using the material that Family Life offers. There are several options that we will be offering churches and individuals. One is a weekend session where we coordinate with a church and as many couples as want to attend. We would present the material over a 3-day weekend. The other is a weekly session for 7 weeks, meeting once a week, and



then sending the couple's home with some homework before the next meeting. One of the things that I would like to see God do through this is, after we have finished the material, that God would raise up a couple who would be willing to do the same training in their church or home.

Please be in prayer with us as we continue seeking God's direction and His will for the ministry of Word of Truth. Edna and I are asking that God use us in however He sees fit to reach a world that needs Him and His restoration.
